What to expect during Royal Court Interviews:

Check-in

We recommend that you complete the online application before arrival, however there will be a limited number of laptops available on-site to apply. Plan to check-in personal items including purses and cell phones. You will be given a claim ticket and all items will be stored in a secure place.

Orientation

Past Royal Court members will share their experiences and explain the step-by-step process for the day. This is also an opportunity to ask questions about the interview process, the Tournament of Roses or the benefits of being on the Royal Court.

Interview

Each applicant will be asked a question and be given 15 seconds to answer. The Queen & Court Committee, made of up 12 Tournament of Roses Members, will be asking the question. The committee is looking for a combination of qualities, including public speaking ability, youth leadership, academic achievement, and community and school involvement.

Next Steps

By Wednesday, September 14, 2022, an email will be sent to all participants of the first round of interviews. The email will notify applicants if they are invited to continue to the next round in the interview process or if round one was the end of their experience.

FAQs

What should I wear?

Wear something that you feel confident and comfortable in. In the past, participants have chosen to wear a dress, skirt and top, or pants suit.

Do I need to bring my school transcripts?

No, transcripts are not required for the first interview. Transcripts will be required for future interviews, should you continue through the process.

How long can I expect to be at Tournament House?

Please plan to be at the interview for 1 - 2 hours.

Interviews will be held at Tournament House, 391 S. Orange Grove Blvd. in Pasadena..
